



RENOVATION CASE STUDY:

house rules holiday house 2015

THE BRIEF

We were contacted by a prospective customer from Sydney enquiring about the construction of a holiday house at Toogoom. We then met him on site. At the meeting he advised us that it would be for a TV show and would we be interested in taking on the role of Principal Contractor/Builder. Once confidentiality agreements had been signed we were then told it was for "7's House Rules" holiday home prize giveaway, and it would be a renovation of a removal house and was to be completed in 7 days.

THE BUILDING

We, as the principal contractor/builder had to supply all local subcontractors, roofers, carpenters, electricians, plumbers, plasterers, painters, landscapers, tilers and concretors to complete the job within the said time frame. The house arrived on the Wednesday on 2 semi trailers with work commencing immediately with the footing tie down and roof replacement. Work continued for 6 days with obstacles to hurdle, including time delays waiting for the TV couples to make decisions, which resulted in early starts and very late finishes daily. We can confirm the renovation was completed within the 7 days, with no less than 50 sub contractors on site on the last day, plus contestants, producers & camera crews.

THE OUTCOME

We are very proud to be associated with the completed house and felt the product and workmanship, produced in such a short time frame, was of a high standard which is a testament to our wonderful trades who gave up their time to be a part of this project.
